As we begin the second year of our two-year **Before All Things** discipleship journey, it's time to celebrate what God has done and remain focused on the vision of where we are going. We will once again go before the Lord and ask, 'Is He truly before all things in my life?'

Before All Things is a holistic discipleship journey; the preeminence of Christ must affect every area of our lives. Over the next three months we will study the book of Colossians and look at putting Him **Before All Things**...in His church, in our hearts, in our day to day lives, and in our mission.

This booklet provides a basic outline of the four big initiatives of **Before All Things**. It also serves as a study guide for the first four weeks of Colossians, during which we will put Him **Before All Things** in His Church.

And so, from the day we heard, we have not ceased to pray for you, asking that you may be filled with the knowledge of his will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God. – *Colossians 1:9-10*

As we move forward, I want to remind you of two very important things:

- *This initiative is first and foremost about Jesus Christ and what He accomplished on the cross. He went first. He gave His best. We respond by putting Him before all things in our lives.*

• Our number one goal is 100% participation. We want every single person who calls The Church of Eleven22 home to go before the Lord and ask, 'Is He truly before all things in my life?'



As we move through this study, I hope each of you will find the role God has for you in this movement. Regarding the **Before All Things** initiative, we believe you will fit into one of three categories:

1. **NEW:** You are new to Eleven22. Welcome to the family! Get on board with what God is calling our church to and make a 12-month commitment.

2. **PERSEVERE:** You made a commitment in 2015 and you have experienced hard times. My word to you is: persevere. Catch up, keep up, and finish the race strong.

3. **GROW:** You made a commitment in 2015 and over the last year you grew in your faith or finances...either way you need to pray like crazy to determine if God is calling you to increase your commitment.

Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us, to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever. Amen. — *Ephesians 3:20-21*

THE HISTORY OF OUR MOVEMENT

In **2008**, under the leadership of Pastor Jerry Sweat, Beach Church started a weekly worship gathering to reach ages 18-35, the 'lost' generation – the un-churched, the de-churched. Pastor Jerry asked Pastor Joby Martin to lead this new service held Sundays at 11:22am.

Easter 2009, we began to show signs of being more than just a weekly worship service. Over 1,500 people poured in to celebrate the resurrection. We began to be affectionately referred to as Eleven22.



By early **2011**, a distinct Eleven22 culture and vibe were firmly established. As God continued to expand the impact of Eleven22, He also began to clarify the vision. Pastor Jerry Sweat challenged Pastor Joby Martin that it was time for him to become the Lead Pastor of a church, and he wanted to help him launch a church. With that, the movement known as The Church of Eleven22 was born to be a place for all people to discover and deepen a relationship with Jesus Christ.

September 23, 2012,

The Church of Eleven22 held its first worship gathering in its new facility and over 3,000 people attended the first weekend.



January 2012

Beach Church and Eleven22 kicked off a joint capital campaign called **Upon This Rock**, the fruit of which built out The Church of Eleven22 facility at Beach and San Pablo in Jacksonville, Florida.



In the **Spring of 2013**, families were being turned away due to lack of space for children. We announced our first expansion — **The Restore Project**. Rooted in Acts 15, the call was to restore the final 20,000 square feet of the building at Beach and San Pablo so more children and adults could come and discover a relationship with Jesus Christ.



THE HISTORY OF OUR MOVEMENT

January 2014 brought 1,000 new people to experience the Gospel. Our newly 'restored' space opened, including the Sanctuary where 500 people can worship.



In **August 2015**, as part of a community transformation effort, Hope's Closet opened — a thrift store designed to bring dignity to those it serves, and to offer the hope of Jesus to all who enter.

In **June 2013**, more than 200 people were baptized in the ocean at our first Beach Baptism, while hundreds of friends and family watched from the beach.

^
By **December 2014**, almost 5,000 people were worshipping at Eleven22 each weekend. Since opening day in 2012, there were 1,045 people who surrendered their lives to Jesus and 465 people were baptized.

In **September 2015**, just three short years after launching, we celebrated salvation number 3,000. That's 3,000 lives eternally changed!

January 10, 2016, we launched our second campus, The Church of Eleven22 at Baymeadows, in an old sports bar with more than 1,600 people in attendance.

On **January 8, 2017**, The Church of Eleven22 launches our Mandarin campus, walking out the Before All Things vision of planting the Gospel in local communities.

October 2015, we launched our biggest initiative to date — the **Before All Things** generosity initiative — a two-year discipleship journey where we learn and live out the reality that Jesus is Before All Things.

June 2016, we celebrated 309 people surrendering their lives to Jesus at Beach Baptism.

INITIATIVES OVERVIEW

In 2015 we felt God was pushing us to take not just a step, but a leap of faith. We sought the Lord and knew He was calling us to embark on a journey of holistic, generosity discipleship. In response to His call, The Church of Eleven22 launched our **Before All Things** initiative in January 2016.



As a church we asked ourselves, “What would it mean for our generosity if we had a full grasp of the preeminence of Christ?” The response to this initiative was overwhelming and we know His power at work within us took us beyond anything we could have asked or imagined.

As we move into 2017, the primary goal is still 100% participation. We want 100% of us who call Eleven22 home to go before God and have a life-changing encounter as it relates to our generosity.

Because of what God did and continues to do, we are expanding the **Before All Things** vision. With the participation of new people, current commitments being kept, and many people increasing their commitment, we are believing God for a total of \$36 million by the end of the two years.

INITIATIVE ONE

CULTIVATE MINISTRY

Our first priority is to continue to hold weekly worship gatherings and connect people through serving, disciple groups, and short-term mission trips to transform communities locally and globally. Being disciple-making-disciples is at the core of Eleven22.

INITIATIVE TWO

PUT DOWN ROOTS

San Pablo was our first campus and will continue to serve as the launch pad for our mission as a movement for all people to discover and deepen a relationship with Jesus Christ.

Just as a couple in their early years of marriage might choose to purchase their own home, we are doing the same with our San Pablo campus. Facilities are important, because they help facilitate ministry.

Thanks to locking down a purchase price four years ago, we can purchase a \$14 million building for \$7.8 million. The goal is to have this process wrapped up by the end of 2017.

INITIATIVE THREE

PLANT THE GOSPEL

We will continue to partner with you in reaching friends and family with the good news of Jesus Christ by providing identical worship experiences in neighborhoods throughout Jacksonville.

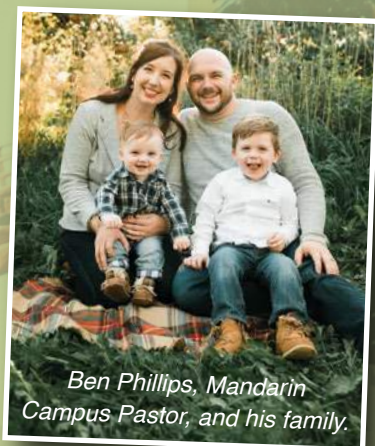
In 2015 we purchased the building at 8133 Point Meadows Parkway and on January 10, 2016 our Baymeadows campus opened. Today more than 1,200 people attend our Baymeadows campus and one-third of our attendees are new to Eleven22.

In 2016 we purchased the building at 4911 Losco Road and on January 8, 2017 our Mandarin campus opens. We trust God's favor will be on this location as well and anticipate serving thousands of people for years to come.

In 2017 we are believing God will continue to expand our movement in new directions; north of the San Pablo campus and in St. Johns County.

Each campus offers live worship, identical kids experiences and Pastor Joby preaching via video.

INITIATIVE FOUR

SOW GOSPEL SEED

Because we have been so richly blessed, we respond by sowing God's blessing in Jacksonville and around the world.

LOCAL PARTNERSHIPS

Our goal is to partner with local organizations to help break the cycle of poverty by providing access to employment. In 2016 we established two partnerships and created our own jobs program through Hope's Closet that have collectively helped **175 people** become employable.

SALVATION ARMY: PATHWAYS TO HOPE FOR MEN

The Church of Eleven22 purchased and provided a full computer lab where **72** men are being trained to become employable.

OPERATION NEW HOPE: JACKSONVILLE PORT ACADEMY

The JPA was created to close the gap between JAXPORT employers and skilled potential employees by providing in-demand skills training. The Church of Eleven22 has provided funding for **100** men and women to attend the Academy for training.

HOPE'S CLOSET JOBS INITIATIVE

Our jobs program was developed and saw its first fruits last year. In December we celebrated **three** people who graduated from our six-month, holistic program that provides job training experiences as well as equips participants through counsel and prayer to discover God's purpose for their lives and to be dependent on Him.





CHURCH PLANTING

Our goal is to partner with church planting organizations to sow Gospel seed into communities locally and globally through equipping pastors and providing resources for churches to be planted. We are focused on this effort in three ways:

EQUIPPING CHURCH PLANTERS

The Church of Eleven22 hosts a church planting conference each year and provides coaching through our partnership with the Acts 29 Network. We're also a lead of the Church Planter City Group; and are launching a church planting residency program.

LOCAL CHURCH PLANTING

The Church of Eleven22 is helping train pastors and is supporting a few area churches as they launch and share the Gospel with people in their communities.

GLOBAL CHURCH PLANTING

The Church of Eleven22 is equipping pastors and planting churches around the world, in places such as Brazil, Costa Rica, East Africa, India, Turkey, and the United Kingdom. In Brazil and East Africa alone, we've planted **64** churches, constructed **two** church buildings, and have **500** pastors in training.

We're also spearheading a partnership between the Acts 29 Network and Compassion International which will change the trajectory of countless lives over the next 30-40 years.

GENEROSITY JOURNEY

The Generosity Journey is a tool designed to help you move money from being an idol to money being a tool for God's Kingdom. The Journey focuses on the condition of our hearts further transforming us into the likeness of Christ.

Each step of the Journey represents growth in a lifestyle of generosity and sacrifice.

These are not steps you slowly ascend to get to God, but rather a way to evaluate your growth in generosity. The Apostle Paul encourages us to grow in every facet of our walk with Christ, including the grace of giving. *(2 Corinthians 8:7)*

First-Time Giver

This type of giver is someone who decides to give for the first time. This is someone who decides to give something and trust God and the leaders of the Church with this gift.

Consistent Giver

This type of giver is someone who decides to give something and to give it on a consistent basis. This often requires planning, and sometimes this might be a reason for someone to set up recurring gifts online or to become disciplined in giving through the giving boxes.

Intentional Giver

This type of giver begins asking the question, "Why am I giving more to my cell phone bill than I am giving to God? Should I be giving to God more than I give for my mortgage each month?" This giver starts to make their giving an intentional choice that reflects how they feel about it in relation to other things they spend their money on.

Sacrificial Giver

This type of giver begins to ask the question, "Am I giving in a way that changes me? Am I giving in a way that causes my lifestyle to be different to reflect the transformation Christ is making in me?" A Sacrificial Giver's commitment to giving actually governs the rest of his/her lifestyle. A Sacrificial Giver has a giving commitment that is "larger than their current situation" so that they have to adjust the rest of their expenditures to meet that commitment.

Lifetime Giver

A Lifetime Giver is no longer asking the question, "God, how much are you asking me to give?" A Lifetime Giver is asking the question, "God, how much are you asking me to keep?" They ask this so that they can release the rest into Kingdom purposes. Much like a Sacrificial Giver makes a commitment that will govern his/her monthly and annual decisions, a Lifetime Giver makes a lifetime or longer-term giving commitment that governs his/her larger decisions like homes, cars, investments, and the like.

WHAT WE ASK OF YOU

As we move through this study, we pray God speaks to each of us regarding our participation. We believe you will fit into one of three groups:

1. NEW: You recently joined our family and are wondering, “What is Before All Things and how do I become part of it?” Before All Things is for everyone who calls The Church of Eleven22 home. We welcome you to the family and ask you to get on board with what God is calling us to and make a 12-month commitment.

2. PERSEVERE: Others of us made a commitment a year ago and hard times have come. You may have struggled with job loss, a career change, or unexpected medical expenses. We know the Lord is faithful and He will provide. Our word to you is: persevere. Catch up, keep up, and finish the race strong.

CULTIVATE MINISTRY — Hold weekly worship gatherings. Connect people to the family through serving and Disciple Groups. Send people on short-term mission trips. Transform communities locally and globally. Being disciple-making-disciples is at the core of Eleven22.

PUT DOWN ROOTS — Purchase our San Pablo campus as a permanent home for The Church of Eleven22.

PLANT THE GOSPEL — Launch our third campus in Mandarin and expand our reach into other communities throughout Jacksonville with the Gospel.

SOW GOSPEL SEED — Be a conduit of God’s blessing by partnering with organizations in Jacksonville to further our jobs initiative program and in Brazil and East Africa to plant 100 churches in these areas of the world.

Our expanded goal for the full two years of Before All Things is \$36 million. We have received approximately \$31 million in commitments and expected gifts, praise God! Over the next 12 months, we will need both continued giving of current commitments as well as new and increased commitments in order to reach the goal we feel God is putting before us.
